The scholarship is for Albemarle-Charlottesville area students who are academically competitive and active in the community. Scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$500 for winners attending a 4-year college or university and \$250 for an individual attending a 2-year college or trade school. Those individuals expecting to enroll fulltime in a college, university, or trade school who are interested in applying for scholarship must complete the following a scholarship application packet & return it to the **Albemarle-Charlottesville NAACP by 5:00pm, April 15th**

1. Application

Complete a paper or electronic application and return it to the Albemarle-Charlottesville NAACP.

2. Essay

The essay will address the topic, "Why Is The NAACP Still Needed Today" and contain a minimum of 300 words.

3. Transcripts

This will include any and all courses taken as part of the High School course of study.

4. Admittance Letter

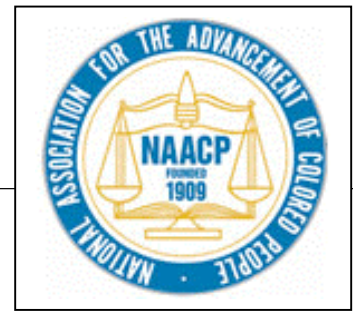
Applicants must submit a letter of admittance, and or a letter of intent to attend a 2 or 4-year college, university, or trade school.
